



Extreme Weather Policy

Oakleigh Netball Club (ONC) extreme weather policy is based on the recommendations of Netball Victoria policies for junior netball in extreme weather conditions.

- On competition game day, CDNA Officials are responsible for making the decision to cancel a game. Refer to the CDNA Weather Policy 2021
- On a training day, the ONC Club Co-ordinator is responsible for deciding whether to cancel, using this policy as a guide. Team Managers will be advised who will advise their teams.
- Players must arrive at the courts on time for all games and training unless otherwise notified.
- Training will only be cancelled in weather conditions that would result in cancellation of a game as teams need to practise in all conditions.
- The ONC Co-ordinator and Coaches will always assess weather conditions and the court surface and will modify training as required.

Wet Weather Conditions

ONC training will be cancelled in the event of sustained heavy rain, hail and /or lightning or storms, or if the courts are considered unsafe. ONC training will not be cancelled because it is cold, or in light rain

Hot Weather Conditions

ONC training as outlined in the Netball Australia Junior Policy, games and training should be modified or cancelled if the ambient temperature reaches 34 degrees C or above.

Responsibility for notifying of cancellation

Matches: CDNA will notify clubs if matches are cancelled prior to rounds starting, by email or notices on their website. Team managers must monitor this and notify the coach and all players immediately by SMS.

Training: The ONC Co-ordinator is responsible for monitoring weather conditions prior to training time and notifying Team Managers who will in turn notify their teams by SMS approximately 1 hour prior to the start of training based on the current weather forecast.
